## Workshops

### Introduction to Calligraphy: \$65

*Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday, Jul 17-19, 9-10:30am*  
*Instructor: Anne Kazez, Ages 15 – adult. Limit: 10.*

A workshop on the basics of calligraphy, starting at the beginner level. Acquire the basics of using pen and ink, and then learn how individual letters are formed and how they are combined to create words. Students will develop an eye for angles, shapes, and spacing as they relate to calligraphy. Please include your email at time of registration so the instructor can send you a supply list.

### Kid's Mosaic Workshop \$45/session

*Sunday, Jun 24, 1:30-3:30pm*

*Instructor: Tami Prince, Ages 7-11. Limit: 8.*

Join us for a creative Sunday afternoon class making mini mosaics! Create a colorful abstract mosaic trivet on tile from tumbled glass. A fun workshop designed especially for a child's creative expression. Please bring disposable gloves for grouting.

## 4-Week Sessions

### Young Artist's Workshop – Eco-Art: \$45

*Saturdays, Jul 14-Aug 4, 10:30-noon; Ages 7-9; 12:30-2pm;*  
*Ages 10-14.*

*Instructor: Valerie French, Limit: 10 students. Supplies included.*

In this 4-week workshop, we will use the elements of our world as inspiration to create interesting and unusual works of art. During the 4 classes, we will focus on our Earth, our Air, our Water and our Sun, by using these elements in our artwork. Students will create a nature weaving, a recycled mobile, a color field creek painting, and a garden cyanotype, based on the works of Dougherty, Calder, Frankenthaler and Ayre.

### Watercolor Techniques: \$70

*Thursdays, July 12-Aug 2, 1-3pm*

*Instructor: Casey Moorman, Ages 15-adult. Limit: 10.*

In this class, we'll experiment with different techniques to achieve unique effects within watercolor. We'll use table salt, rubbing alcohol, and cellophane – as well as different types of paper. Some previous watercolor experience is helpful but not required. Please bring paints, brushes, and water container with you to class.

### Beginning Glass Mosaics: \$70

*Saturdays, Jul 7-28, 10-11am*

*Instructor: Tami Prince, Ages 15 – adult. Limit: 8.*

This class is designed for, and directed toward, the inexperienced beginner. Five percent lecture, ninety-five percent hands-on. You'll be given instructions in basic mosaic supplies and techniques, as well as familiarization and practice with stained glass: design, cutting, grinding, adhesives, grouts. At the end of the class, students will have a completed glass-on-glass one of a kind mosaic sun catcher ready for framing and eternal enjoyment. Please bring safety glasses.

## 5-Week Sessions

### Stained Glass Class: \$80

*Wednesdays, Jun 27-Aug 1, 6-8pm*

*(Please note: no class on Wednesday, Jul 4.)*

*Instructor: Tami Prince, Ages 15-Adult. Limit: 8.*

This class is for all levels. Beginning students will create a stained glass sun catcher. Returning students can fine tune their skills for more complex designs. Instruction will cover cutting, grinding, foil methods, and soldering. This class will send you on your way to becoming a glass artist and you will leave class with a finished piece. Supplies included. Students are asked to bring goggles (from any hardware or craft store) and to wear closed-toe shoes.

### Sketching the City: \$100

*Sundays, Jun 24-Jul 29, 1-3pm*

*(Please note: No class on July 15th.)*

*Instructor: Kelley Booze, Ages 18+. Limit: 10.*

Explore Springfield from a new perspective! Learn to sketch and draw from direct observation while appreciating the urban landscape. Each lesson will begin at a new site. Bring your sketchbook, pencils and pens. Please include your email at time of signup, a list of locations will be emailed prior to the first class. All locations will be fully accessible.

### Yoga in the Gallery: \$60

*Sundays, Jun 24 -Jul 22, 10-11am*

*Instructor: Casey Moorman (RYT 200), Ages 15-adult. Limit: 10.*

Join us in the galleries for an hour-long Vinyasa class that strengthens, increases flexibility, and reduces stress. Vinyasa is a movement-based form of yoga that focuses on flowing with the breath. Modifications will be given as needed to ensure that this class is accessible to everyone. Casey is a 200-hour registered yoga instructor. Please bring your own mat.
